- Fall Term 2020 credit hours for the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry include credit hours of students completing courses that were suspended during Winter Term 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Beginning in Fall Term 2021, credit hours include all University College of the North Cohort Nursing courses as the University of Manitoba becomes the primary institution of record.
- The Department of Chemistry has transitioned most courses with embedded laboratories to for-credit laboratory courses, effective Fall Term 2021. Comparisons to previous years should be made with caution.
