Notes:

- Undergraduate Student Credit Hours (UGSCH) are the hours of weight associated with a course indicating the relative weight of the course in the program of studies. There is often a correlation between lecture class hours and hours of credit; for example, a full course carrying six (6) hours of credit may entail three (3) hours of lectures per week, both terms. This report includes:
 - all distance education credit hours, including Independent Study, on-line courses, and group-based study;
 - all courses taught off-campus with stipend from other than faculty, college, or school resources;
 - all courses taught through remote-learning.
 This report excludes:
 - credit hours declared as "Challenge for Credit";
 - 6000-level courses associated with graduate programs.
- Credit hour totals reflect combined Fall Term and Winter Term activity, as at November 1 and March 1 respectively. Because Winter Term 2021 started two weeks later than usual and Winter Term 2022 started three weeks later than usual, adjusted dates of March 15 and March 21, respectively, were used for those terms. Due to rounding, some totals may not match the sum of the individual department, or faculty/college/school, figures.
- As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, Fall Term 2020 and Winter Term 2021, and Fall Term 2021 and Winter Term 2022 may not be comparable to other years. Comparisons should be made with caution.
- Select courses previously associated with the Department of Biosystems Engineering have been reassigned to the Department of Engineering. Comparisons to previous reports should be made with caution.
- Effective July 1, 2017, the Department of Food Science and the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences merged into the Department of Food and Human Nutritional Sciences.
- The Department of English, Film, and Theatre changed its name to the Department of English, Theatre, Film & Media in 2018.
- The Department of Native Studies changed its name to the Department of Indigenous Studies, effective January 1, 2022.
- The Department of Sociology changed its name to the Department of Sociology and Criminology in 2018.
- The Faculty of Engineering changed its name to the Price Faculty of Engineering in 2020.
- The Department of Geological Sciences changed its name to the Department of Earth Sciences, effective July 1, 2021.
- The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.
- Fall Term 2020 credit hours for the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry include credit hours of students completing courses that were suspended during Winter Term 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Includes credit hours from the accelerated program run during the summer term.
- Beginning in Fall Term 2021, credit hours include all University College of the North Cohort Nursing courses as the University of Manitoba becomes the primary institution of record.
- Beginning in Fall Term 2019, Pharmacy began transitioning from a B.Sc. Pharmacy to a PharmD program.
- The Department of Chemistry has transitioned most courses with embedded laboratories to for-credit laboratory courses, effective Fall Term 2021. Comparisons to previous years should be made with caution.
