6. The Department of Native Studies changed its name to the Department of Indigenous Studies, effective January 1, 2022.
7. The Department of Geological Sciences changed its name to the Department of Earth Sciences, effective July 1, 2021.
8. Credit hours for the Max Rady College of Medicine do not reflect Undergraduate Medical Education teaching.
9. Credit hours in the College of Nursing for Summer Term 2022 include students completing courses that were suspended in the previous Winter Term.
10. Increase due to the transition from a B.Sc. Pharmacy to a PharmD program, beginning in Fall Term 2019.
11. The Department of Chemistry has transitioned most courses with embedded laboratories to for-credit laboratory courses, effective Fall Term 2021. Comparisons to previous years should be made with caution.
