Beginning Fall 2020, graduate students are assessed continuing fees in each academic term for which they are not paying program fees.

4. The College of Pharmacy average tuition rate includes a \$3,600 fee for clinical fieldwork.

5. Tuition fee for Rehabilitation Sciences represents fee for Respiratory Therapy.

6. Commencing Fall 2020, international students in PhD programs will no longer be assessed international differential fees.

All PhD students will be assessed the same program fees, both domestic and international.

7. MBA tuition fees are assessed at a rate of \$559.36 (International - \$765.26) per credit hour. The program consists of a total of 60 credit hours.
