2. Winter Term reports are based on data extracted as at March 1. Because Winter Term 2021 started two weeks later than usual, and Winter Term 2022 started three weeks later than usual, adjusted dates of March 15 and March 21, respectively, were used for those terms.
3. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, year-over-year comparisons should be made with caution as figures may not be comparable.
4. Beginning in Fall Term 2020, the Asper School of Business increased the number of students admitted each year.
5. The Faculty of Engineering changed its name to the Price Faculty of Engineering in 2020.
6. Other Dentistry includes B.Sc. Dentistry students and students in the International Dentist Degree Program.
7. Other Medicine includes B.Sc. Medicine students and physicians enrolled in Continuing Medical Education courses.
8. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there were no Medicine Externals in Winter Term 2022 or Winter Term 2021.
9. Beginning in Fall Term 2021, enrolments include all University College of the North Cohort Nursing students as the University of Manitoba becomes the primary institution of record.
10. Pharmacy is transitioning from a B.Sc. Pharmacy to a PharmD program, beginning in Fall Term 2019.
