Winter Term 2023 (as at March 1)
Summary Report
March 9, 2023

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, comparisons to other years should be made with caution as figures may not be comparable. Enrolments and credit hours during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic were higher than pre-pandemic levels. In 2022, as pandemic restrictions have eased, enrolments and credit hours have returned to pre-pandemic levels.

Winter Term Enrolment

In Winter Term 2023, enrolment at the University of Manitoba decreased by 0.7%. Total enrolment decreased from 29,484 students in Winter Term 2022 to 29,266 students in Winter Term 2023. Part-time enrolment decreased, however the decline was largely offset by an increase in full-time enrolment. Part-time enrolment decreased 18.3%, from 5,512 students in Winter Term 2022 to 4,505 students in Winter Term 2023. Full-time enrolment increased by 3.3%, or 789 students, from 23,972 students to 24,761 students.

Undergraduate enrolment decreased 0.9%, from 24,990 in Winter Term 2022 to 24,771 in Winter Term 2023. Graduate enrolment increased 0.2%, or 8 students, with 3,794 students in Winter Term 2022 and 3,802 students in Winter Term 2023.

Credit Hours

Total undergraduate credit hours increased 1.7% from Winter Term 2022 to Winter Term 2023. Undergraduate credit hours in Winter Term 2022 were 254,099 compared to 258,411 in Winter Term 2023. Distance and Online Education credit hours, excluding remote-learning, increased 12.5%, from 32,305 to 36,354.
