1. The COVID-19 pandemic had substantial impacts on the University of Manitoba in 2020, 2021, and 2022, with the impacts diminishing over the years that followed. Comparisons involving covid-affected years should be made with caution.
2. The Summer Term academic schedule has been restructured, beginning in 2021. Comparisons to previous years should be made with caution.
3. The Faculty of Engineering changed its name to the Price Faculty of Engineering in 2020.
4. Enrolment in the College of Nursing for Summer Terms 2020 and 2022 include students completing courses that were suspended in the previous Winter Terms.
5. Effective Fall Term 2022, the Bachelor of Nursing moved from a two-term to a three-term program delivery model. Comparisons to previous years should be made with caution.
6. Effective Summer Term 2023, the Bachelor of Nursing moved from two to three intakes per calendar year. Comparisons to previous years should be made with caution.
7. Pharmacy is transitioning from a B.Sc. Pharmacy to a PharmD program, beginning in Fall Term 2019.
8. Includes William Norrie Centre, Distance and Northern programs.
9. The University 1 program was introduced in 1998-99 for students with limited or no university experience.
10. Graduate Studies includes pre-master's, master's, doctoral, occasional and diploma students. Graduate totals include only students taking credit courses in Summer Term.
