- Categories of Graduation, Continuation or Attrition track students regardless of movement from original, or any, faculty at the University of Manitoba.
- Includes only those students who entered these faculties in their first year at the University of Manitoba. Does not include students who transfer from University 1 or any other faculty.
- Small programs increase the variability of outcomes.
- Includes students who transferred from another university to the University of Manitoba.
- Includes students who transited from University 1 to either Arts or Science. Analysis begins when entering Arts or Science.
