Winter Term Enrolment

As at End of Course Change, enrolment at the University of Manitoba was up 2.5%. Total enrolment increased from 29,304 in Winter Term 2023 to 30,029 in Winter Term 2024. Similar to Fall Term, Winter Term enrolment has seen growth in the number of new students and has benefitted from expansions in health-related fields, which have contributed to an increase in the number of full-time students. Full-time enrolment increased 3.9%, from 25,155 students in Winter Term 2023 to 26,144 students in Winter Term 2024. Part-time enrolment decreased by 6.4%, from 4,149 students to 3,885 students.

Undergraduate enrolment increased by 2.5%, from 24,883 in Winter Term 2023 to 25,497 in Winter Term 2024. Graduate enrolment increased 2.5%, from 3,729 to 3,822.

Credit Hours

Total credit hours at End of Course Change increased from 263,431 in Winter Term 2023 to 272,832 in Winter Term 2024, an increase of 3.6%. Distance and Online Education credit hours, excluding remote-learning, increased 1.0%, from 37,719 to 38,097.
