**Fall Term Enrolment (as at November 1)**  
**Summary Report**

**Fall Term Enrolment**

As at the official reporting date of November 1, overall enrolment in Fall Term 2024 was 31,334 students, increasing 1.8%, from 30,783 students last year. Full-time enrolment increased 2.6%, from 26,787 students in Fall Term 2023 to 27,495 students in Fall Term 2024. Part-time enrolment decreased by 3.9%, from 3,996 students to 3,839 students. Although overall enrolment increased, there has been a significant shift in the makeup of the student population, with domestic enrolment increasing 3.6% while international enrolment decreased 4.5%.

Undergraduate enrolment increased by 2.1%, from 26,114 students in Fall Term 2023 to 26,651 students in Fall Term 2024. Graduate enrolment decreased by 1.4%, from 3,964 students in Fall Term 2023 to 3,910 students in Fall Term 2024.

**Credit Hours**

Total undergraduate credit hours in Fall Term 2024 increased 2.6%. Credit hours in Fall Term 2024 were 284,839 compared to Fall Term 2023 credit hours of 277,594. Credit hours for courses offered through Distance and Online Education decreased 0.6%, from 33,252 credit hours to 33,055 credit hours.

**International Students**

International enrolment decreased 4.5% overall, from 6,991 students last year to 6,675 students this year. The decline in international enrolment can be attributed to a significant decrease in the number of new international students, as they decreased from 1,863 students to 1,303 students, a decline of 30.1%.

**Indigenous Students**

Self-declared Canadian Indigenous enrolment was up 9.5%, to 2,994 students in Fall Term 2024, from 2,735 students in Fall Term 2023. Indigenous students currently make up 9.6% of the overall student population.
