All students are required to successfully complete [GRAD 7500](#) Academic Integrity Tutorial (0 credit hours) within their first term of initial registration. Students must also register for [GRAD 7300](#) prior to applying to any ethics boards which are appropriate to the student's research or within the student's first year, whichever comes first.

The course-work requirement will consist of a minimum of twelve credit hours of 7000-level course-work. Of these 12 credit hours: Students will be required to take AHS 7000: Research and Practice in Applied Health Sciences, a lecture/seminar course in which faculty members from the participating academic units take part (3 credits). •Nine credit hours may be chosen from a combination of graduate courses from the participating units or from other faculties outside the participating units that offer graduate courses related to applied health sciences. Courses must be selected by the student in consultation with the advisor. All courses must be recorded on the "AHS Internal Program Approval Form", and submitted to the AHS Program Assistant for approval by the AHS Program Director.
