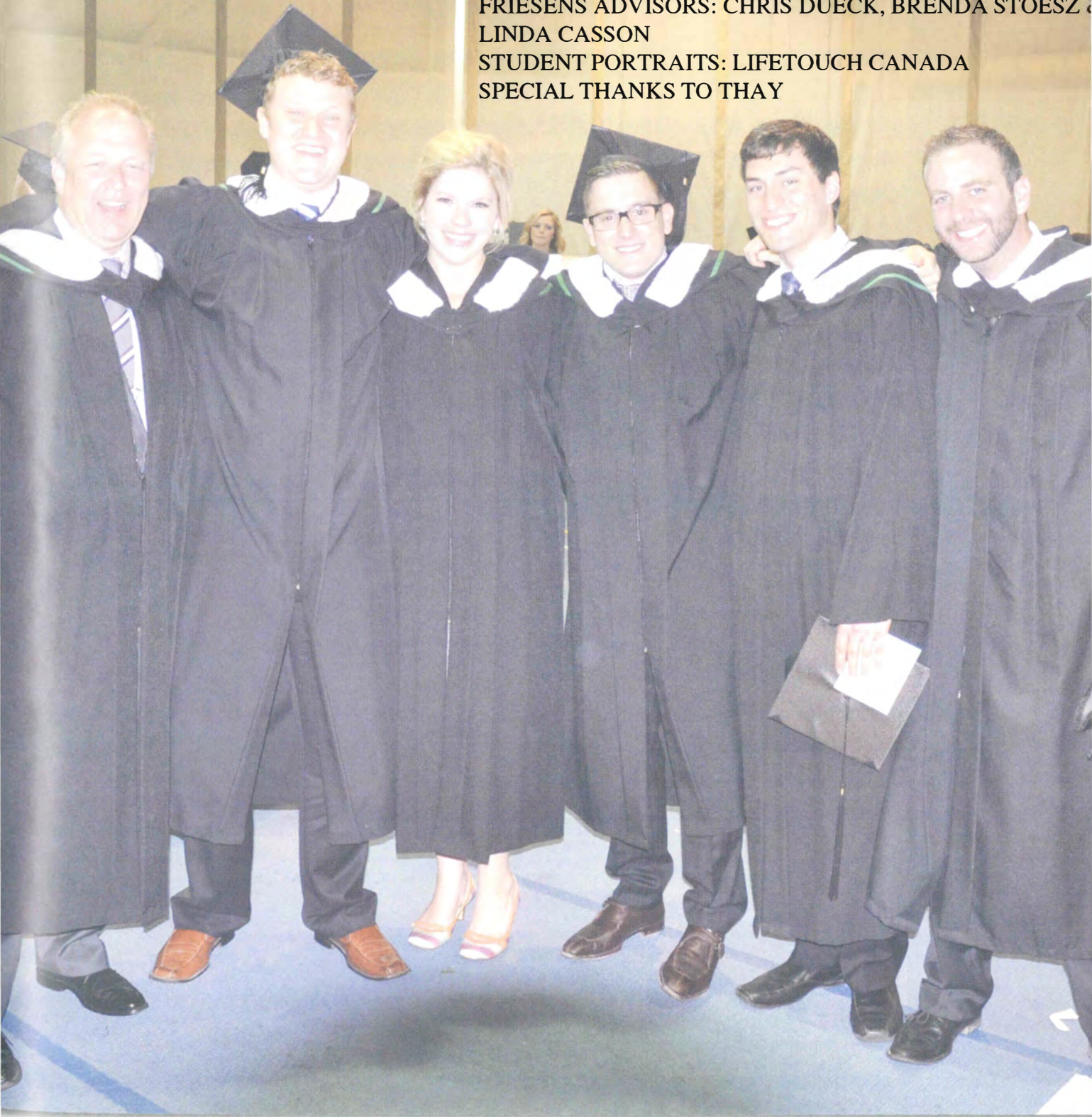

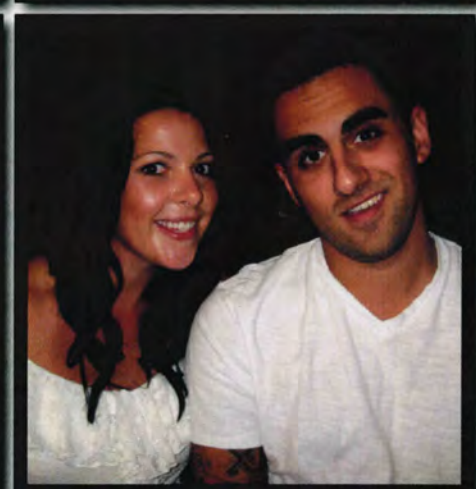

ORIENTATION WEEK



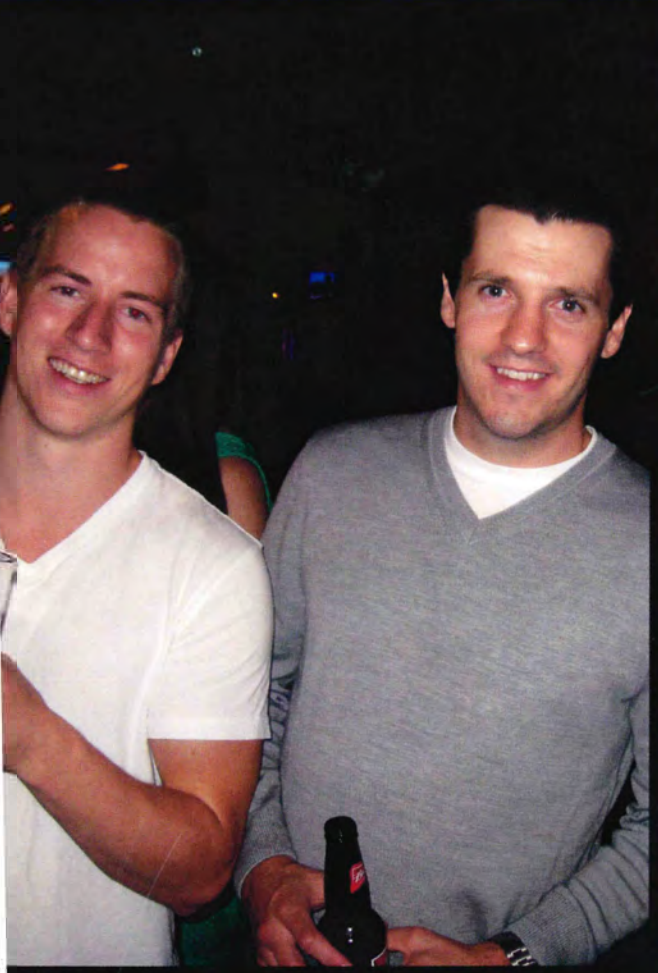

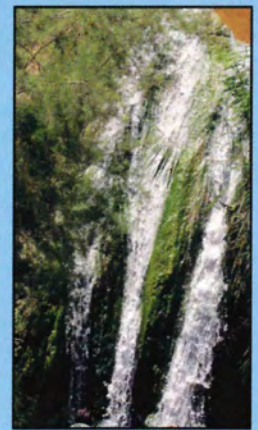
COFFEEHOUSE
