To all the graduands, who also leave us this year, go my very best wishes whether you stay in Manitoba or decide to venture forth into other more luxuriant provinces.

## Dedication to Professor Hu

Professor Shih-Sheng Hu, Head of the Law Library, left Manitoba this year to accept a position at the University of Toronto as Professor of Law and Chief Law Librarian. Professor Hu was with us since his appointment in 1967 as Associate Professor of Law and Head of the Law Library. In 1971, he was promoted to Professor. He is also a member of the Manitoba Bar.

Professor Hu was educated in Taiwan, where he received his B.A. in Law, and in Toronto, where he received his LL.M. and B.L.S. He has been exceptionally active in law librarianship in terms of publications and service on local, national, and international committees. He is the author of the Manitoba-York-Windsor modified KF classification schedule and a Manual for Canadian Law Libraries (1968). He is a prominent member of the Canadian Association of Law Librarians, Western Association of Law Librarians, and the American Association of Law Libraries, and has served each of these groups in various capacities. For example, since 1965 he has been on the Cataloguing and Classifications Committee of the American Association of Law Libraries. Also, he has been on several University of Manitoba committees such as the Senate Planning and Priorities Committee, The Exec-

utive of the Senate Library Committee, and the Faculty of Law Building Committee, to name but a few. Professor Hu is generally, and genuinely, regarded as one of the premiere Law Librarians in North America. Besides achieving the intellectual and professional successes noted above, he was throughout his tenure at Manitoba a master of human relations. He developed and encouraged friendly and efficient working relationships among Library employees, the faculty, students, and the legal profession. We thank him for his outstanding contributions to legal education in Manitoba, and we wish him and his family great success in Toronto. Library People and Bookends





## **Valedictory Address**

I must confess that my most vivid memory of Law School happened on the first day. We were all assembling in the moot courroom for the first orientation session. A tall brown-haired girl carrying the usual number of notebooks walked in, took a long look around, and with a look on her face that said quite plainly "you must be kidding," turned and left the room never to be seen again. Many times during the last three years I've wished her happiness.

Any way, for better or worse, it's finally over and we're now to be unleashed upon an unsuspecting world. But let's not think too hard about that tonight. There is more pressing business upon which to attend. As Lord Mansfield once said, "I'd rather have a bottle in front of me than a frontal lobotomy." Bartender, pour a round for the house. Charge it to the University. Hell, we've earned it.

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
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#### The Dean's Ditty
