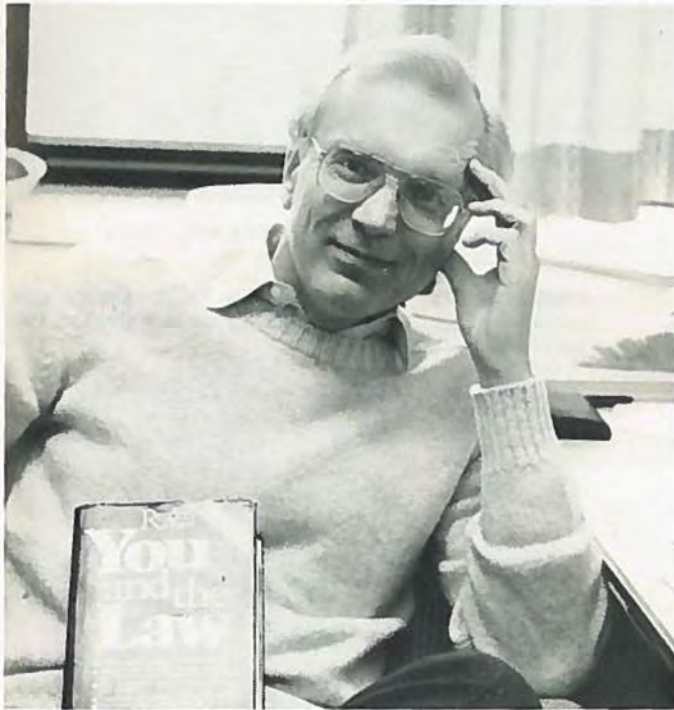

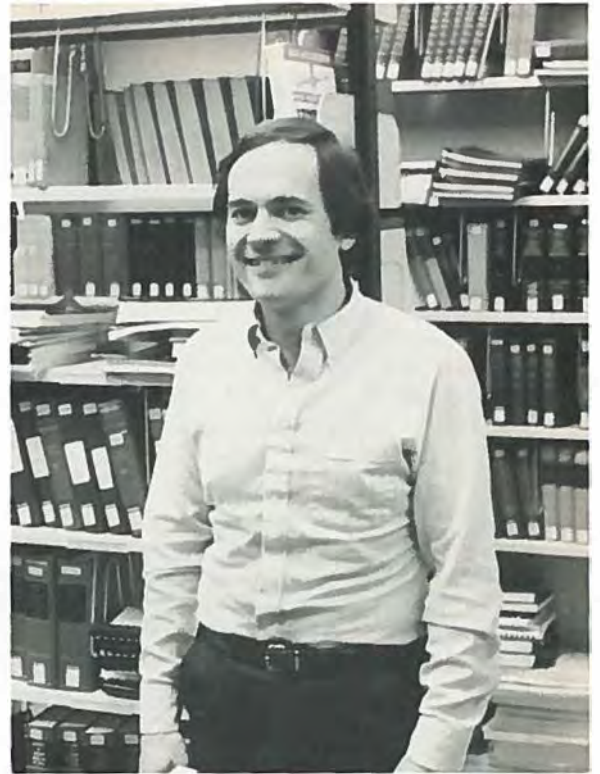

# A FAREWELL TO DEAN JACK LONDON

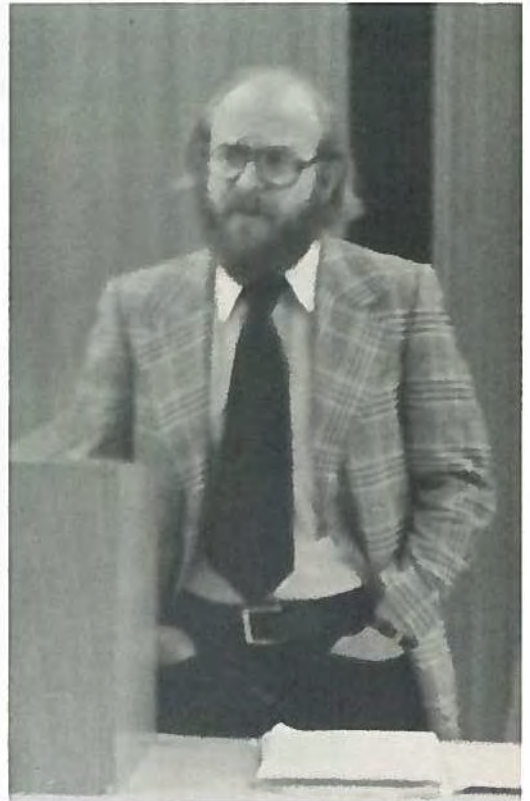

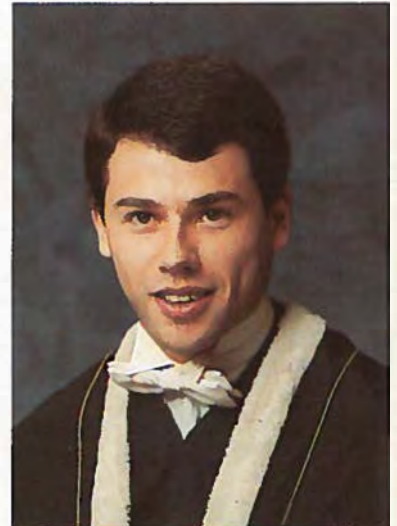
**VICTOR BELLAY**

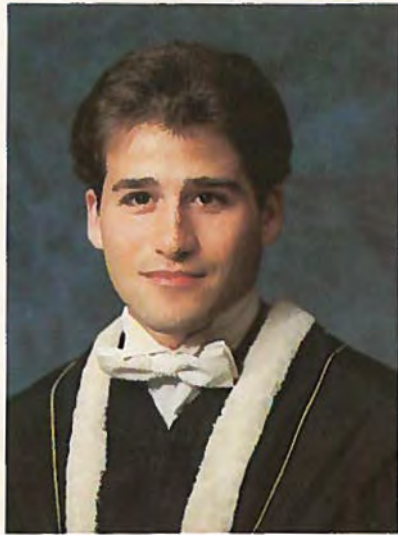
**PHILLIP CALVER**

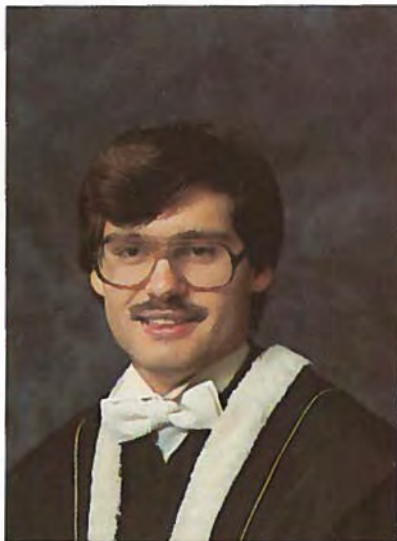
**COLETTE CHELACK**

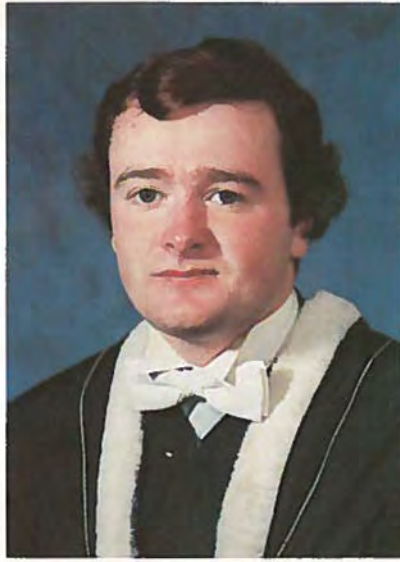
**ALAN DIDUCK**

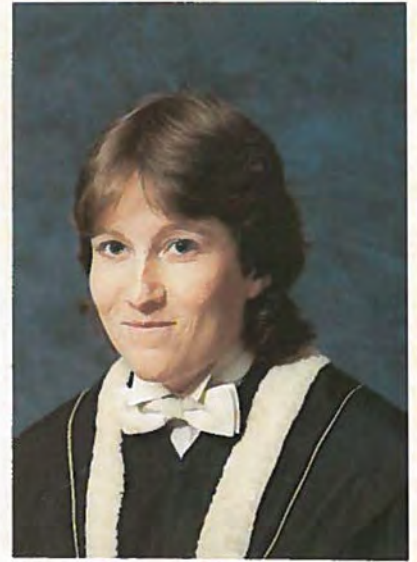
**NEIL DUBOFF**

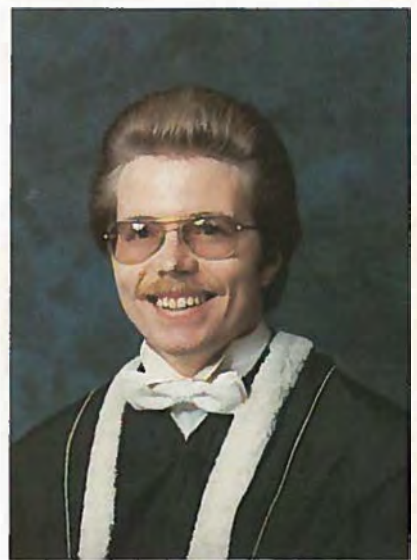
**COLIN FORSYTH**

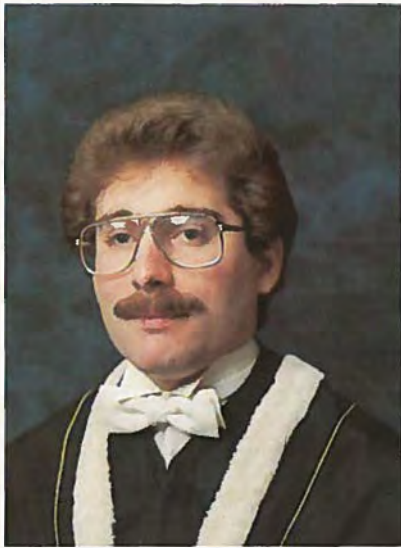
**CALVIN FRIESEN**

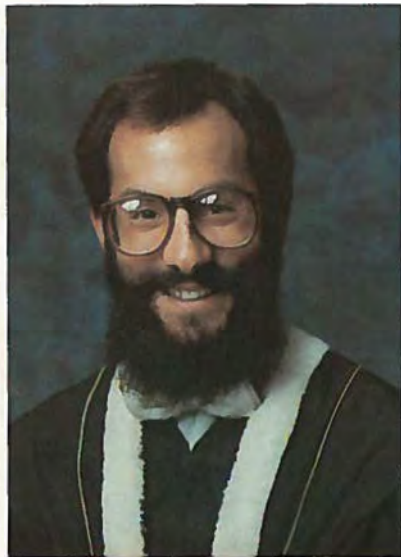
**ALAIN GAUTRON**

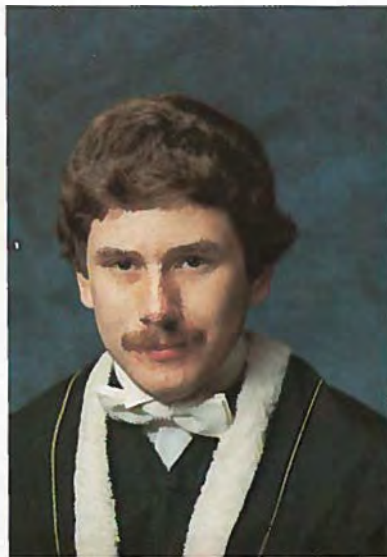
**DONALD GEORGE**

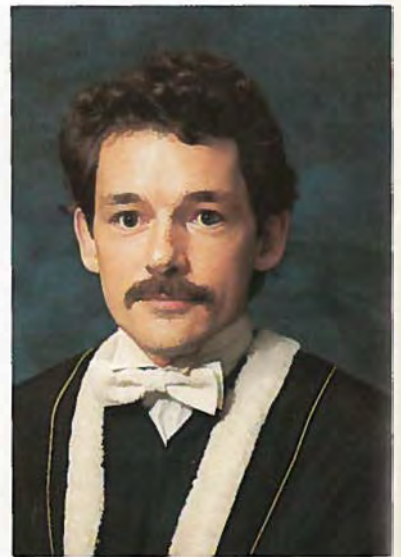
**MICHAEL HANDLER**

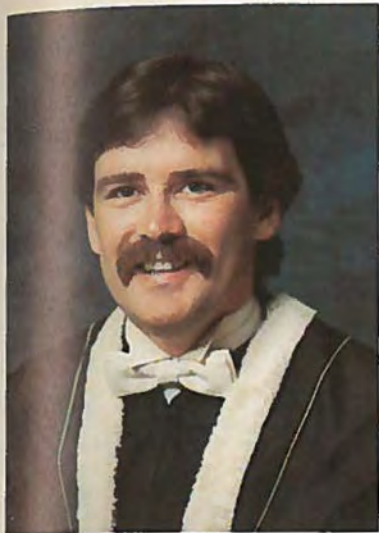
**GORD HANNON**

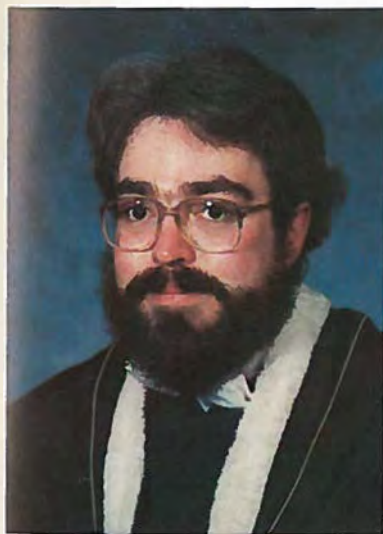
**INGRID HIBBARD**

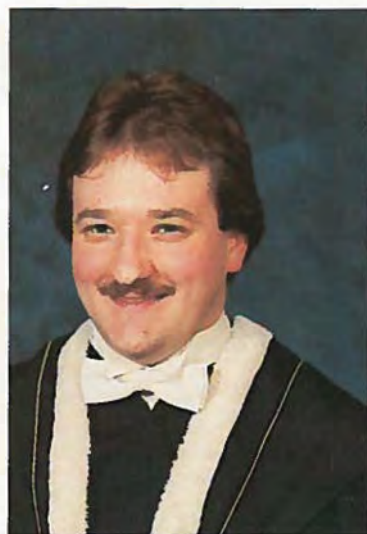
**DAVE JACKSON**

**BILL JOHNSTON**

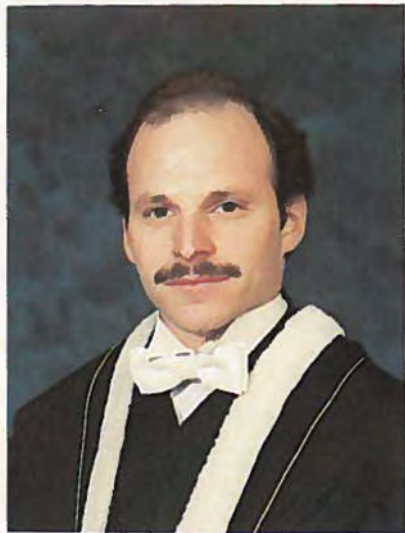

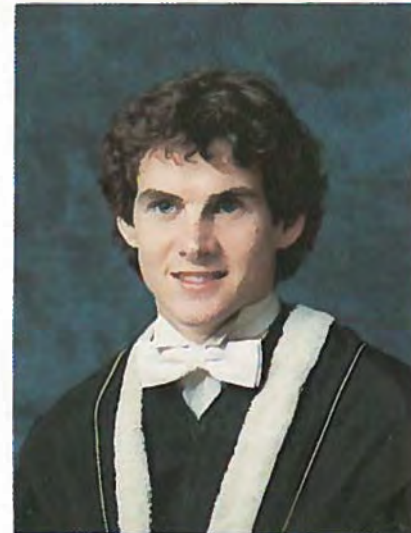
**JOEL KAY**

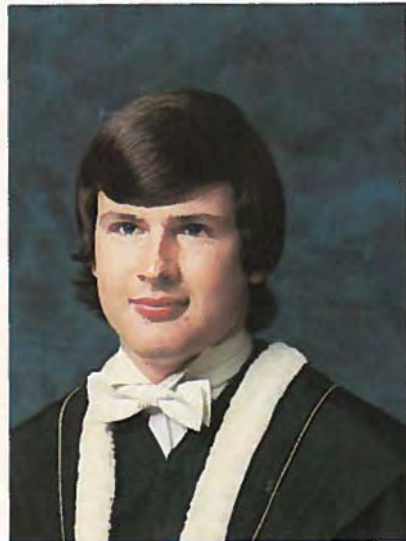
**LISA KELLER**

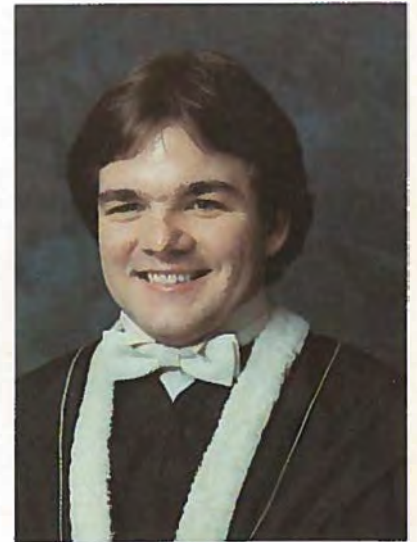
**BRENDA MATTE**

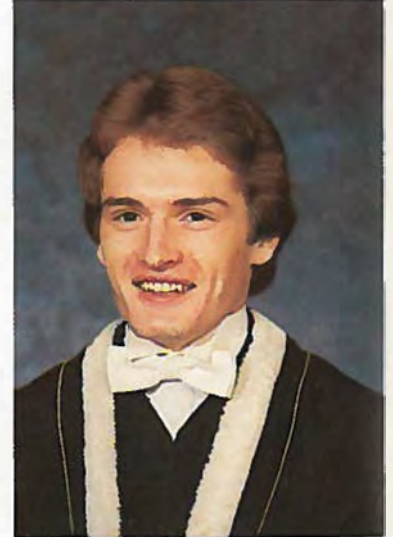
**JAMES MULLER**

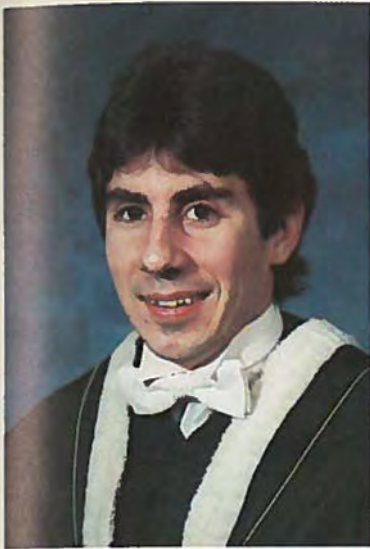
**PAUL NORMANDEAU**

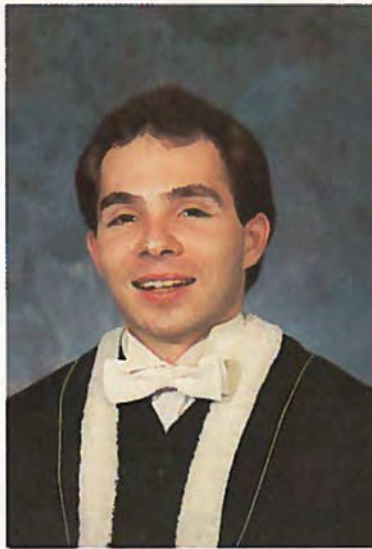

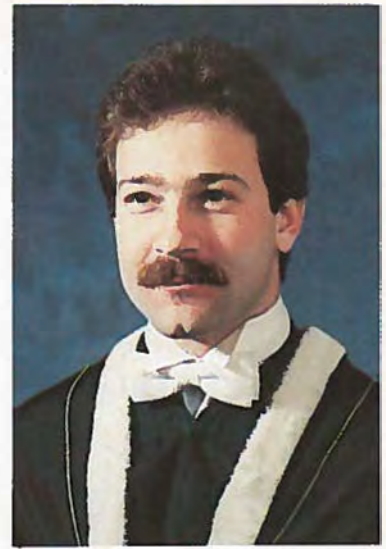
**DAVE PALAMAR**

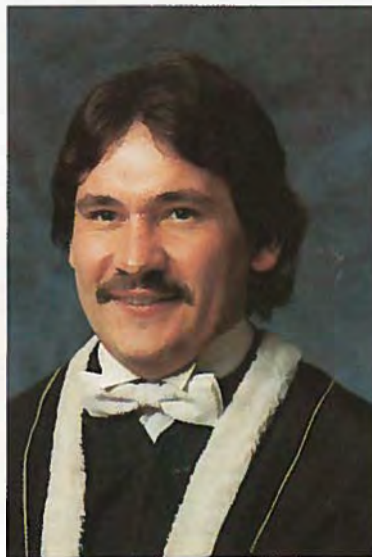
**JOSEPH POLLOCK**

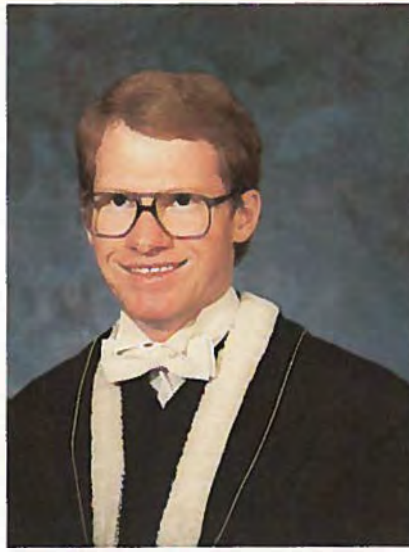
**WOLF RIEDEL**

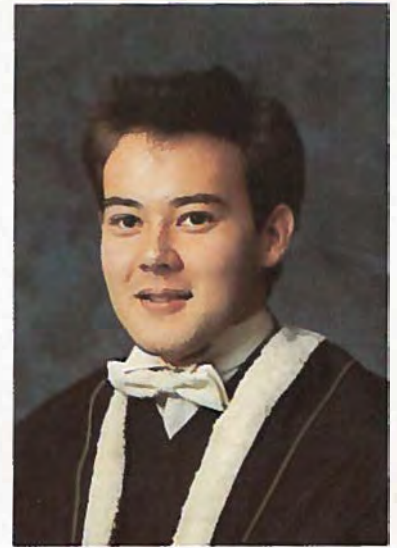
**DON TAYLOR**

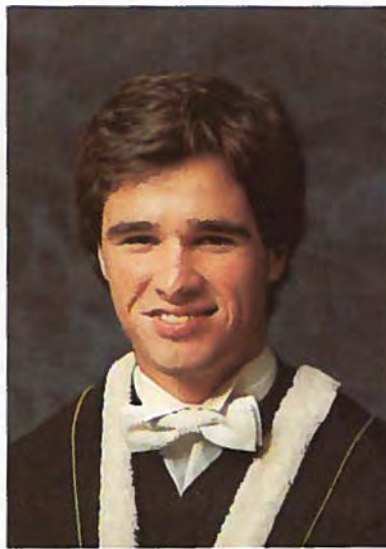
**MICHAEL THOMSON**

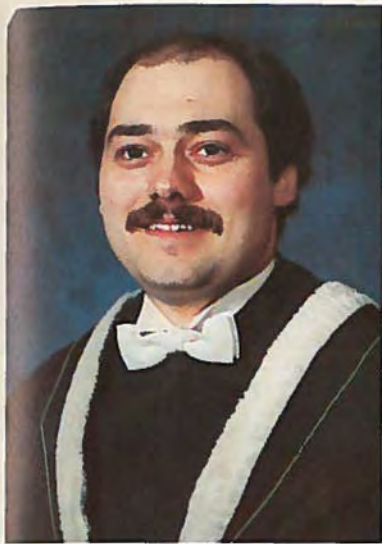
**STEPHEN VINCENT**

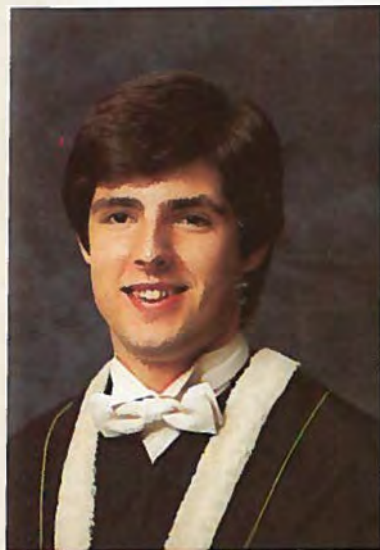
**CAMPBELL WRIGHT**
