About

The Children’s Hospital of Winnipeg Pediatric Orthopedic Section provides subspecialty care to the children of Manitoba, Nunavut and Northwestern Ontario and is the only tertiary pediatric hospital in the province. Approximately 9,500 outpatients are seen and treated each year at the Health Sciences Center and SSCY. Approximately 850 operations were performed by the Pediatric Orthopedic group in 2021 (a Pandemic year). All pediatric orthopedic trauma requiring operative treatment is seen through the Children’s Hospital of Winnipeg.

Each staff Pediatric Orthopedic surgeon has subspecialty expertise in areas such as complex congenital upper extremity, neuromuscular disease, pediatric hip disease, lower extremity reconstruction and foot and ankle. Opportunities to gain experience in oncology and spine pathology can be facilitated based on applicant interest.

To gain experience in Pediatric Orthopedic trauma, the fellow will take call. The fellow will participate in bedside and formal resident teaching rounds. Opportunities to participate in staff-only case discussion rounds will be provided to enhance fellow learning. The fellow will be responsible for completing a single research project over the course of the year, mentored by one of the Pediatric Orthopedic attending surgeons.
