Bachelor of Music students in the Performance program are required to present two (2) Credit Recitals, while Bachelor of Music students in Composition and all Post-Baccalaureate students are required to present one (1) Credit Recital.

CREDIT RECITAL TIMES AND FORMATS

To book your Credit Recital, please submit the Undergraduate Credit Recital Booking Form to the Facilities and Events Coordinator, Sue Stone Scott (Sue.StoneScott@umanitoba.ca). The deadline is **December 2, 2024 at 4:30 pm**. If the Credit Recital is not booked by December 1, we cannot guarantee the preferred date requested and an additional \$25 late fee will be charged. Once booked, the Credit Recital cannot normally be rescheduled, unless permission of the Associate Dean is granted.

The Recital Program Approval Form must be submitted to music@umanitoba.ca a minimum of one (1) month before the Credit Recital.

Finalized Credit Recital programs are to be emailed to music@umanitoba.ca in Microsoft Word format a minimum of one (1) week before the Credit Recital. The program must follow the Recital Program Template provided online at <https://umanitoba.ca/music/student-experience/forms>. If the program is not received by the deadline, students will be responsible for formatting their own programs.

Please consult the Recital Formatting Guide for instructions for the template, formatting content, etc.

NOTE: The Desautels Faculty of Music office will provide an electronic file and 30 black and white copies of the Credit Recital Programs.

- **Last date in the 2024-25 Academic year to have a Credit Recital is April 25, 2025.**
- Credit Recitals should be treated as professional engagements. Students are fully responsible for all organization. Start early!
- Book the venue only after confirming the date with any collaborating musicians who will be assisting you. The date may not be changed except with approval from the Associate Dean.
- Plan any assistance needed to help the Credit Recital run smoothly well ahead of time. Contact Facilities Coordinator Sue Stone Scott (Sue.StoneScott@umanitoba.ca) for assistance.
- Any formal booking of an On Campus Recital requires a \$100 non-refundable, non-transferable Recital fee. Failure to return the room to good order, or failure to clear equipment and personal belongings immediately after the Credit Recital may result in additional charges. Contact the Front Office (music@umanitoba.ca) for methods of payment and more information about fees.
- Contact Facilities Coordinator Sue Stone Scott (Sue.StoneScott@umanitoba.ca) to book the dress rehearsal. Students registered in MUSC 3550 may book a one (1) hour dress rehearsal before the Credit Recital. Students registered in MUSC 4560 or MUSC 5560 may book a two (2) hour dress rehearsal before the Credit Recital.
