1. GENERAL CONFERENCE SPONSOR

Sponsoring the overall conference demonstrates your commitment to student research and education and will help us realize our goal: "To provide a forum for profiling student research in Epidemiology and Biostatistics". The level of support you provide is matched with increasingly attractive benefits (see Sponsorship Benefits, page 4). The levels are:

4. Silver	\$1,000-\$1,999
5. Bronze	\$501 - \$999
6 Friends	\$500 or less

2. SPECIAL EVENT SPONSOR

A) **Dinner \$4,000 (Premium)** (one available)

At this event, a full dinner will be served to the delegates and guests. When you sponsor the dinner, your organization will be recognized on a sign at the entrance to the room, you will receive recognition/thank you during the opening remarks, and you will receive all of the benefits that accompany a Premium Level Sponsorship (see Sponsorship Benefits, page 4).

B) Mentorship Luncheon \$3,500 (Platinum) (one available)

The Mentorship Luncheon will be open to all conference delegates and judges. Students will have the opportunity to ask a panel of experts questions about their career. When you sponsor the Mentorship Luncheon, your organization will be recognized on a sign next to the food service area and you will receive all of the benefits that accompany a Platinum Level sponsorship (see Sponsorship Benefits, page 4).

C) Mentorship Breakfast \$2,500 (Gold) (one available)

The Mentorship Breakfast will be open to all conference delegates and judges. Students will have the opportunity to meet both faculty and individuals from industry to discuss professional development topics. When you sponsor the Mentorship Breakfast, your organization will be recognized on a sign next to the food service area and you will receive all of the benefits that accompany a Gold Level sponsorship (see Sponsorship Benefits, page 4).

D) Refreshment Break & Poster Sessions \$1,500 (Silver) (two available)

The two refreshment breaks during the poster judging will be an opportunity for conference delegates to network and reflect between oral presentation sessions. When you sponsor one of the Refreshment Breaks, your organization will be recognized on a sign next to the food service area and you will receive all of the benefits that accompany a Silver Level sponsorship (see Sponsorship Benefits, page 4).

3. DELEGATE ITEMS SPONSOR

A) **Delegate Tote Bags (Gold)** (one available)

Cotton tote bags will be given to each delegate at check-in. Each tote bag will carry informational material for the conference. B) **Delegate Lanyards (Silver)** (one available)

4. <u>SCIENTIFIC AWARDS SPONSOR</u> (Friends) (number available varies)

Monetary awards will be given to the students with the best scientific abstracts for oral, rapid fire, and poster presentations (first prize: \$200; second prize: \$100; third prize: \$50). 5. BOOTH/KIOSK SPONSOR (Friends)
