



**HIGHLIGHTS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING of March 21, 2013**

- President Barnard has opted to give one update annually at the April reception.
- An on-line survey about health and dental benefits and association activities conducted by CURAC was completed by Jay Goldstein. Results to be sent to us.
- UMRA will not be able to send a delegate to the CURAC National conference this year without financial support from the University.
- The \$25,000 lifetime maximum supplementary health benefit for those who are covered is a family maximum.
- Terms of reference for a general bursary under UMRA have been drawn up and will be forwarded to the University Senate.
- Retirees donated \$133,000 to the United Way Campaign (up from \$126,000 last year). Retirees' contributions represented 25% of the total raised by the University of Manitoba.
