May 30, 2019*

- The Committee agreed that it needs to encourage more of our members to serve on the various committees of UMRA. That task is now under way.
- Daniel Sitar represented UMRA at the CURAC Annual Meeting in Guelph this year, and agreed to serve on their Health Care Policy Committee.
- The Committee agreed that UMRA is currently not sufficiently resourced to host an Annual CURAC Meeting after 2022, but exploratory discussions would be initiated to determine the possibility that Winnipeg might host the meeting in the future, since UMRA played a major role in the founding of CURAC.
- Planning for the annual summer outing for members of UMRA will continue under the leadership of Vice-President Janet Sealey.
- Our Benefits and Pension Committee continues to meet with Central Administration to explore and consider modifications to the terms of their operation.
