JOVAN JOVANOVIC Dr. Jovan Jovanovic passed quietly on June 1, 2014, in the 86th year of his life, after a short illness in Toronto, Ontario. Jovan has joined his beloved wife, Anica, of 60 years, who predeceased him earlier this year, and they are at peace together. Jovan is survived by his loving children Goran and Vera, their dear spouses Susa and Fania, and four grandchildren: Natasha, Gregory, Roxanna and Kira. Jovan was born July 30, 1928, in Rakovica, Yugoslavia and moved to Canada to study Physics in 1955. After living in the United States and England in pursuit of his studies, he returned to Winnipeg in 1966 to become a Professor of Nuclear Physics at the University of Manitoba. In 2006 Jovan moved with Anica to Toronto to be with family. Jovan's research was on the link between energy consumption, economic growth, and human longevity.
