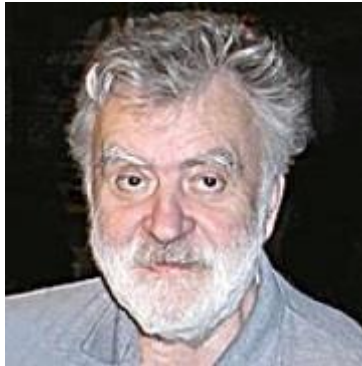


## OLDRICH LUKES
