DR. BANSI (BEN) LAL MUJU On Tuesday, August 2, 2011 at 3:00 a.m., Dr. Bansi (Ben) Muju passed away at St. Boniface Hospital at the age of 76 years in the presence of his family. Left to lovingly remember Ben is his wife Jai; daughter Kavita; son Sanjay; granddaughter Sunaya; as well as his extended family and friends. Ben was born in Kashmir, India and was the third of a family of four brothers. He was educated at the Technical University of Brunchweig, Germany, where he completed his Diplom in Chemistry. He earned his doctorate in nuclear chemistry from the University of Leicester, England. Ben did his post-doctoral research at the Memorial University of Newfoundland and the Atomic Energy of Canada at Chalk River, Ontario. He and Jai finally settled in Winnipeg where they raised their two children and he taught at the University of Manitoba.
