7. IHI Update, Alex Thielmann

1. Launching Nightmare/ night care event for 1st and second year medical and nursing students. Students will stay overnight on a ward and receive updates on their developing patients cases throughout the night. 1st year students will be acting as the patients and 2nd years will act as the

nurses and physicians dedicated to following and treating patients where appropriate. TO TAKE PLACE ON FEBRUARY 4th Christina Ateah and Dr. Heather Dean are very excited about this events and the opportunity to expand it in the coming years.

2. The IHI OPEN SCHOOLS courses online is open to researchers, faculty and students wishing to access it. Dedicated to patient safety education and by completing courses online you can receive a certificate. It should be one of the goals of all MaHSSA members to complete the IHI open schools online classes. – THERE IS NO FEE for students.

8. Winter IPE Event- brainstorming

Students will work together in inter professional teams to work towards completing cases and will then present on their ideas / solution to a group of judges composed of inter professional faculty members. THE DEADLINE to submit your ideas for the format of this event is MONDAY JANUARY 17th.

9. MaHSSA Constitution: Reporting Structure for IPE programs

1. Several of the participants mentioned that the structure that we presented for our organization could be improved. At this time it was the general consensus that maybe the issue is in the presentation of our organizational structure as no one has raised concerns about our operation before. We will see if this comes up again.

10. Voting privileges for IPE programs
