

ESTIMATE OF TUITION & LIVING EXPENSES

Tuition and School Fees

Tuition and school fees vary according to the program of study and course load. For an estimate of the tuition and school fees for your program, please refer to the links on the following page: http://umanitoba.ca/student/records/fee_information_hub.html

International Centre Exchange Program students: Students coming to the University of Manitoba (U of M) through the International Centre Student Exchange Program pay tuition to their home universities and not to the U of M. However, all exchange students will be required to pay the following fees to the U of M: University of Manitoba Students' Union (UMSU) fees and field trip fees, if applicable. Health insurance fees will vary according to the length of study and the health insurance options chosen.

Living Expenses

The following is an estimate of costs, in Canadian dollars, for a single student living in Winnipeg at a very modest level for one calendar year (12 months). Actual living expenses will vary depending on your lifestyle and could be higher than what is estimated below.

For newly admitted students, an estimate of the first-year living expenses:

For returning students:

Clothing	\$600



Telephone	\$720
Transportation (bus pass - May to August)	\$330
Entertainment	\$750
Ongoing costs	\$750

An additional \$4,000 should be added for a spouse and an additional \$3,000 for each dependent to cover 12 months of living expenses.
