The purpose of the *Falconer Emerging Researcher Rh Awards*, is to recognize academic staff who are **early in their research/scholarly/creativeworks careers**, and who (i) display exceptional promise, (ii) high qualities of innovation and (iii) stimulate research colleagues in their own and related disciplines. Each award consists of a research grant of \$12,000. which must be utilized within three years and is non-transferrable.

PART B - CHECK LIST

In order to be eligible for nomination, nominees, **by the application deadline date** must:

- be within eight (8) years of the date on which first of Ph.D. or M.D. or equivalent was conferred (i.e. 2012) or later and in the case of an M.D. who completed residency, it is the year of completion of residency);
- have been employed at the University of Manitoba for a minimum of two (2) years;
- for the Creative Works category only, we will consider nominees with the highest terminal degree for their field (e.g. MFA rather than Ph.D.) and we will consider nominees who have been primarily engaged in the practice of creative works up to a maximum of eight (8) years.

Please note that nominations of individuals who do not meet these eligibility criteria will only be considered when the letter of nomination provides a clear and strong justification for a departure from the eligibility criteria, bearing in mind the overall purpose of the Awards.

Nominations must be supported by:

- a letter of nomination, which: (1) justifies the category (half-a-page) in which the nomination is being made; and (2) addresses in detail (less than three pages) why the nominee qualifies for the award, **with specific reference to each of the three (3) criteria (detailed above)**;
- a brief summary of the nominee's work and its significance/importance;
- three (and not more than three) supporting letters which address the nominee's suitability **in terms of each of the award criteria**. Two of these assessments may be from knowledgeable colleagues at institutions other than the University of Manitoba (excluding trainees supported by the candidate and/or previous research supervisors); and
- a current curriculum vitae of the nominee.
