## WHAT

- Can attend both the roundtable workshops and the individual interview over three months



## HOW

Participate in 1 short background interview, 3 roundtable discussions, 1 individual interview, and 1 final roundtable discussion.

We hope to increase our understanding of cultural safety and its application in addressing family violence within cultural communities.
