Updating a Licence Plate: All motorcycle permits will be issued as a Virtual Permit, a physical permit will not be issued, and the vehicles licence plate will serve as the permit. The applicant must ensure that the licence plate associated with the virtual permit is displayed on the vehicle. To edit the licence plate associated with the virtual permit, complete the Licence Plate Update Form found at www.umanitoba.ca/parking and return to Parking Services or visit our office in person.

Terms & Conditions: The permit is only valid in designated motorcycle parking locations. Motorcycles, moto-scooters and mopeds are considered motor vehicles by the University of Manitoba and require permits 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. Permits are not required during the evening hours or weekends with the exception of spaces designated by signage stating otherwise. This permit is not valid at any time in restricted areas or the Parkade. Parking in accessible spaces, fire lanes, no parking zones, loading zones, landscaped areas is prohibited. Summer permits are not transferrable to the Bannatyne Campus.

Statement of Agreement: In applying for the parking permit indicated on this parking application, you hereby agree to assume all responsibilities for the vehicles registered herein, to adhere to the University of Manitoba Parking Regulations as amended from time to time and authorized by the Board of Governors and to accept all the conditions contained therein. The University of Manitoba Parking Regulations governs all persons using parking vehicles on University premises. By completing and signing this application, you are hereby agreeing to abide by those regulations and acknowledge that failure to pay outstanding parking fines may result in the towing of your vehicle or such other action as the University may deem necessary.
