The English Language Proficiency Requirements for undergraduate admission to the University of Manitoba were evaluated and changes were made which came into effect for applicants for the Fall 2022 term. Applicants applying to the Winter 2022 or Summer 2022 terms will still be evaluated under the previous requirements. Any differences are listed below.

Any current test options, waiver conditions, or exempt countries not listed in this document have remained unchanged. It is important to review this information in conjunction with the full listing of current English language proficiency information which can be found on the Admissions website.

The three years of secondary study must be completed immediately prior to attending the University of Manitoba.
  - Successful completion of post-secondary educations equates to a minimum completion of 72 credit hours or equivalent. The three years of post-secondary study must be completed within two years of attending the University of Manitoba.

The following criteria were **added** as waiver conditions for the English language proficiency requirement and will **NOT** be accepted as waiver conditions for admission to the Winter 2022 or Summer 2022 terms:

# **New Waiver Conditions Effective Fall 2022**

Successful completion of thirty (30) credit hours of university level coursework and six credit hours of transferrable English courses at the 1000 level or higher with a minimum grade of B at a recognized university where English is the primary language of instruction, in a country where English is the primary language (see approved country exemption list). University level study must be completed immediately prior to attending the University of Manitoba.

Graduation from a degree program at a recognized university where English is the primary language of instruction, in a country where English is the primary language (see approved country exemption list). Graduation from the qualifying institution must be within two years of attending the University of Manitoba

Successful completion of the General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE A-Level) with a minimum grade of B in English (non-ESL) at the GCSE/IGCSE/O Level, AS level, or A-Level.

Completion of the Indian Senior School Certificate (ISSC) or the Indian School Certificate (ISC) awarded by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) or the Council for the Indian School Certificate (CISC) with a minimum grade of 75% in the senior English subject.

# Changes to the English language proficiency country exemption list

The following countries were added to the list of countries whose students are exempt from the English language proficiency requirements as of the Fall 2022 term. Applicants to the Winter 2022 or Summer 2022 terms from these countries will **NOT** be exempt from the English proficiency requirements:

- Anguilla
- Gambia
- Liberia
- St. Helena
- Seychelles

The following countries have been removed from the list of countries whose students are exempt from the English language proficiency requirements as of the Fall 2022 term. Applicants to the Winter 2022 or Summer 2022 terms from these countries **WILL** be exempt from the English proficiency requirements:
