

## The University of Manitoba Undergraduate Bursary for Displaced Ukrainian Citizens

The University of Manitoba has funds available to support prospective undergraduate students who are citizens of Ukraine who have been displaced due to war. These students will be seeking to continue their education in Canada in the 2022/23 academic year.

The university will offer up to ten (10) bursaries for the 2022/23 academic year of up to \$36,000 CAN each for tuition, fees, books, supplies & living expenses (including optional room & meal plan in residence) for international students from Ukraine (who are Ukrainian citizens) admitted to UM and registered as full-time students in an undergraduate degree program.

## Criteria:

(1) are international students from Ukraine (Ukrainian citizens) who are displaced by war, and are seeking to continue their education in an undergraduate degree program at the University of Manitoba;

(2) have met the minimum admission criteria and have been admitted to an undergraduate program in any faculty, college, or school at the University of Manitoba;

(3) will be enrolled full-time (minimum 60% course load) in the first year of study at the University of Manitoba for the fall and winter (2022/23) academic year.
