A. Logging in and accessing the Experience Catalogue

You need to be logged into UMConnect to view full details on currently available opportunities in the Experience Catalogue.

To login:

1. On the [UMConnect](#) home page, select **LOGIN**.




2. Select **UM Students** and login using your UMNetID and password.



- Interactive buttons at the bottom


Clicking the title will open an activity window.
