

## **Prize Rules and Regulations**

The Bison Basics Scavenger Hunt contest (the “Contest”) is open to first year University of Manitoba students who are residents of mainland North America (excluding Quebec) and who attended Winter Welcome Day on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The Contest shall be construed and evaluated according to applicable Canadian law. Void in whole or part where prohibited by law. Entry in this Contest constitutes acceptance of these Contest rules (the “Contest Rules”).

### **1. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY**

The contest is only open to new University of Manitoba students starting in the Winter 2023 semester, and who attended Winter Welcome Day on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The University of Manitoba shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility from students participating in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to the University of Manitoba for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. The University of Manitoba reserves the right, in its sole discretion; to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.

### **2. AGREEMENT TO RULES**

By participating in this Contest, the Contestant (“You”) (or, if entrant is a Minor, such Minor’s parent or legal guardian) agree to be fully unconditionally bound by these Rules, and You represent and warrant that You meet the eligibility requirements. In addition, You agree to accept the decisions of the University of Manitoba as final and binding as it relates to the content of this Contest.

### **3. CONTEST PERIOD**

Contest Entries will be accepted from the end of the Coping with Change: Developing a Solid Self-Care Routine Session (2:00 pm) on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023 until January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 5:00pm Standard Time (“CST”).

### **4. HOW TO ENTER**

There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. Enter using the method of entry outlined below. No entries will be accepted by any other means.

The contest will begin right after the Coping with Change: Developing a Solid Self-Care Routine Sessions (session in 206 Tier, 306 Tier, and 200 Fletcher). Session facilitators will provide students with instructions for Bison Basics Scavenger Hunt.

Firstly, students will be required to set up their UM Microsoft accounts. To confirm that students have set up their account, we will provide a QR code to a first-entry Microsoft form that student can then fill in, using their UM Microsoft account. This would provide the students with 1 ticket to the prize draw.

Students will then have the option to visit any number of the 12 stations across campus where they will perform a task and then scan a station specific Microsoft form.

For students in need of assistance in signing into their UM Microsoft accounts, there will be a troubleshooting booth outside the Information Services and Technology office. Students can then fill out the first-entry Microsoft form by scanning the QR code at this troubleshooting booth. This booth is not one of the 12 stations and will not provide students with an extra entry into the draw.

The stations for the Bison Basics Scavenger Hunt are in the following offices / areas:

- UM bookstore
- Student Accessibility Services Exam Centre
- Student Life
- Career Services
- International Centre
- Spiritual Care
- Community Engaged Learning
- UM Libraries
- Academic Learning Centre – Tutor area
- First Year Centre
- Recreation Services
- Indigenous Student Centre

Each station will provide the students with a question to answer or task to do. Students will then scan the QR code at each station, which links to a station specific Microsoft Form that will earn them 1 additional entry to the draw, for up to a total of 13 tickets.

Volunteers and/or staff members will be present at each station to facilitate or answer any questions the students may have.

The entry must fulfill all Contest requirements, as specified, to be eligible to win a prize. Entries that are incomplete or do not adhere to the rules or specifications may

be disqualified at the sole discretion of the University of Manitoba Student Engagement and Success Unit.

## 5. CONTENT TO USE

By submitting the Entry, You understand, acknowledge and confirm that if you win, the University of Manitoba may choose to announce your name or publish your likeness on the University of Manitoba website as a Winner without further obligation or compensation of any kind to You.

## 6. WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

Winners will be selected through a random draw under the supervision of the University of Manitoba Student Engagement and Success Office. The Winner(s) will be notified by email following their selection as a Winner(s). The University of Manitoba Student Engagement and Success Office shall have no liability for Winner's failure to receive notices due to spam, junk e-mail or other security settings or for Winner's provision of incorrect or otherwise non-functioning contact information.

## 7. PRIZES

The prizes are hereafter referred to as the "Prize(s)". A Prize winner is hereafter referred to as a "Winner". We will be selecting 4 winners of \$25 Gift Card to the UM Bookstore and an UMSU swag bag.

The specifics of the Prize shall be solely determined by the University of Manitoba Student Engagement and Success. No cash or other prize substitution shall be permitted except at University of Manitoba Student Engagement and Success' discretion. Prizes are non-transferable.

No substitution of Prize or transfer/assignment of Prize to others or request for the cash equivalent by Winner is permitted. Acceptance of Prize constitutes permission for the University of Manitoba Student Engagement and Success Office to use the Winner's Entry for purposes of advertising and trade without further compensation, unless prohibited by law.

## 8. ODDS

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

## 9. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

The University of Manitoba, its affiliates, representatives, employees, agents, insurers and assigns shall not be in any manner whatsoever be liable or responsible

for theft, loss, technical malfunctions, computer and/or telephone network malfunctions, software problems, online traffic congestion, any human or computer generated error, which may in any manner affect the receipt of Contest entries, the notification of winners, the awarding or distribution of any prize under the Contest.

## 10. INDEMNIFICATION

By entering the Contest, entrant releases and holds the University of Manitoba, its affiliates, representatives, employees, agents, insurers, and assigns, harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any Prize, participation in the Contest, any breach of the Contest Rules, or in any Prize-related activity. The entrant agrees to fully indemnify Releasees from any and all claims by third parties relating to the Contest, including without limitation any claims of infringement of rights to copyright, privacy and/or personality.

## 11. PRIVACY

The University of Manitoba will not be collecting any personal information of any kind during the Contest, other than to notify prizewinners and showcase winning images. This information will not be kept past the Contest finish.

## 12. GENERAL

If for any reason the online portion of this Contest is not capable of being completed as planned including, but not limited to computer virus, bugs, tampering, technical failures or other causes beyond the control of the University of Manitoba, the University of Manitoba reserves the right to cancel, suspend or modify the Contest.

The University of Manitoba, its affiliates, representatives, employees and agents assume no liability whatsoever for damage to any person, or to their computer or other property, arising from their actual or attempted participation in the Contest in any manner whatsoever, or in the awarding of any prize.
