Intramural Timekeepers - Primary Function:


Intramural Timekeepers are responsible for providing accurate score and timekeeping records in accordance with the rules of the designated sport.


Official and Timekeeper Qualifications:

- Must be a full-time student in the Fall and Winter academic session.
- Must be eligible to work on campus and be able to produce required documentation for employment
- Must have a valid Social Insurance Number
- Previous participation as a participant, official, timekeeper or volunteer in sport required
- Must be customer service focused, confident and decisive when working with program participants
- Excellent verbal and physical communication skills
- Positive attitude and excitement about the IM program
- Experience preferred (Officials only)
- Certification an asset (Officials only)
- CPR/First Aid Certification preferred
- Must be available to work evenings
- Must attend general and sport specific mandatory training programs in September
