

Experiential Learning Award Prize Draw Rules and Regulations Student Experience and Development (SEAD) Office

The “Experiential Learning Award Prize Draw” contest (the “Contest”) is open to all University of Manitoba students who are residents of mainland North America (excluding Quebec). The Contest shall be construed and evaluated according to applicable Canadian law. Void in whole or part where prohibited by law. Entry in this Contest constitutes acceptance of these Contest rules (the “Contest Rules”).

1. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

The contest is open to all University of Manitoba students and recent alumni who graduated within 6 months before the application period opened (on or after October 1st, 2024). This includes students from all faculties and programs (including Extended Education), all campuses (including Distance Education students), and all years (undergraduate and graduate students).

The University of Manitoba shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility from students participating in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to the University of Manitoba for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. The University of Manitoba reserves the right, in its sole discretion; to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.

2. AGREEMENT TO RULES

By participating in this Contest, the Contestant (“You”) (or, if entrant is a Minor, such Minor’s parent or legal guardian) agree to be fully unconditionally bound by these Rules, and You represent and warrant that You meet the eligibility requirements. In addition, You agree to accept the decisions of the University of Manitoba as final and binding as it relates to the content of this Contest.

3. CONTEST PERIOD

Applications for the Experiential Learning Award is open from April 1st, 2025, until May 2nd, 2025, 4:30 PM (CDT). Receiving the Experiential Learning Award constitutes an entry for the Contest. Recipients of the Award, and therefore entry to the Contest, will be chosen and published based on the selection criteria outlined in Section 4: HOW TO ENTER, before May 30th, 2025.

4. HOW TO ENTER

There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. Enter using the method of entry outlined below. No entries will be accepted by any other means.

Each person can have a maximum of one entry. Receiving the Experiential Learning Award constitutes an entry to the Contest. To apply for the Experiential Learning Award, applicants must submit an application involving reflection on a UM-recognized experience (through the Experience Record) by May 2nd, 2025. If an experience is not UM-recognized (as previously defined) but has a pending application for recognition by May 15th, 2025, students may receive the award if the experience is approved and they meet all other selection criteria.

To receive the Award and therefore an entry to the Contest, applicants must be eligible for the Award, and their application must answer all application questions, either through a written submission or an alternative reflection method, with each response meeting the minimum required details (e.g., instances, actions, competency areas) specified in the question. More information on the Experiential Learning Award, including the list of questions, will be published on the Experiential Learning Award website.

The entry must fulfill all Contest requirements, as specified, to be eligible to win a prize. Entries that are incomplete or do not adhere to the rules or specifications may be disqualified at the sole discretion of the University of Manitoba Student Experience and Development office.

5. CONTENT TO USE

By submitting the Entry, You understand, acknowledge and confirm that if you win, the University of Manitoba may choose to announce your name or publish your likeness on the University of Manitoba website as a Winner without further obligation or compensation of any kind to You.

6. WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

A Prize winner is hereafter referred to as a “Winner”.

Winners will be selected through a random draw under the supervision of the University of Manitoba Student Experience and Development (SEAD) Office. The Winner(s) will be notified by email following their selection as a Winner(s). The University of Manitoba Student Engagement and Success Office shall have no liability for Winner’s failure to

receive notices due to spam, junk e-mail or other security settings or for Winner's provision of incorrect or otherwise non-functioning contact information.

If a Winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, fails to claim the prize within 30 days from the time award notification was sent, or fails to timely return a completed and executed declaration and release as required, the prize may be forfeited, and an alternate Winner selected. Receipt by Winner of the prize offered in this Contest is conditioned upon compliance with any and all federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations.

Each Tentative Prize Winner (or, if such Tentative Prize Winner is a Minor, such Minor's parent or legal guardian) affirms they have read, understood and agreed to be bound by these Rules, grant all consents required and as contemplated by these Rules, and, in the event You win the Contest, authorize the University of Manitoba to broadcast, publish and disseminate Your name, likeness, voice, city of residence and biographical information in connection with any promotion, publicity, or news, entertainment and/or information purposes, without further consent and without compensation, and releasing the University of Manitoba, its affiliates, representatives, employees and agents from any and all liability of any kind whatsoever arising out of the Winner's participation

7. PRIZES

The prizes are hereafter referred to as the "Prize(s)". We will be selecting 3 Winners of \$100 UM Bookstore Giftcards.

The specifics of the Prize shall be solely determined by the University of Manitoba SEAD office. No cash or other prize substitution shall be permitted except at University of Manitoba SEAD's discretion. Prizes are non-transferable.

No substitution of Prize or transfer/assignment of Prize to others or request for the cash equivalent by Winner is permitted. Acceptance of Prize constitutes permission for the University of Manitoba SEAD Office to use the Winner's Entry for purposes of advertising and trade without further compensation, unless prohibited by law.

8. ODDS

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

9. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

The University of Manitoba, its affiliates, representatives, employees, agents, insurers and assigns shall not be in any manner whatsoever be liable or responsible for theft,

loss, technical malfunctions, computer and/or telephone network malfunctions, software problems, online traffic congestion, any human or computer generated error, which may in any manner affect the receipt of Contest entries, the notification of winners, the awarding or distribution of any prize under the Contest.

10. INDEMNIFICATION

By entering the Contest, entrant releases and holds the University of Manitoba, its affiliates, representatives, employees, agents, insurers, and assigns, harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any Prize, participation in the Contest, any breach of the Contest Rules, or in any Prize-related activity. The entrant agrees to fully indemnify Releasees from any and all claims by third parties relating to the Contest, including without limitation any claims of infringement of rights to copyright, privacy and/or personality.

11. PRIVACY

The University of Manitoba will not be collecting any personal information of any kind during the Contest, other than to notify prizewinners and showcase winning images. This information will not be kept past the Contest finish.

12. GENERAL

If for any reason the online portion of this Contest is not capable of being completed as planned including, but not limited to computer virus, bugs, tampering, technical failures or other causes beyond the control of the University of Manitoba, the University of Manitoba reserves the right to cancel, suspend or modify the Contest.

The University of Manitoba, its affiliates, representatives, employees and agents assume no liability whatsoever for damage to any person, or to their computer or other property, arising from their actual or attempted participation in the Contest in any manner whatsoever, or in the awarding of any prize.
