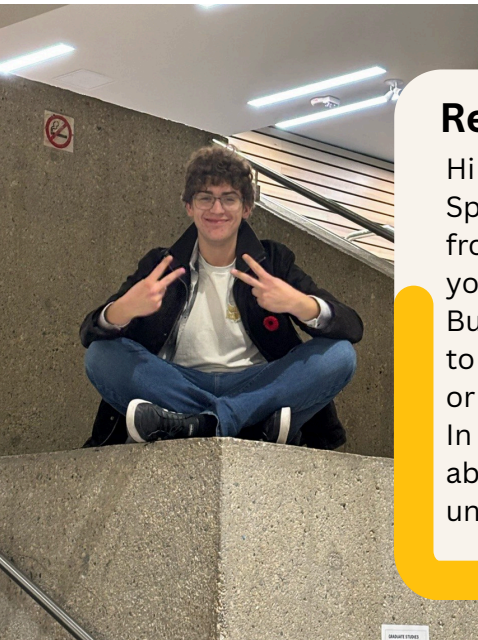


Senior Resident Advisor (2nd Floor): Emika Kongmamornsaichol

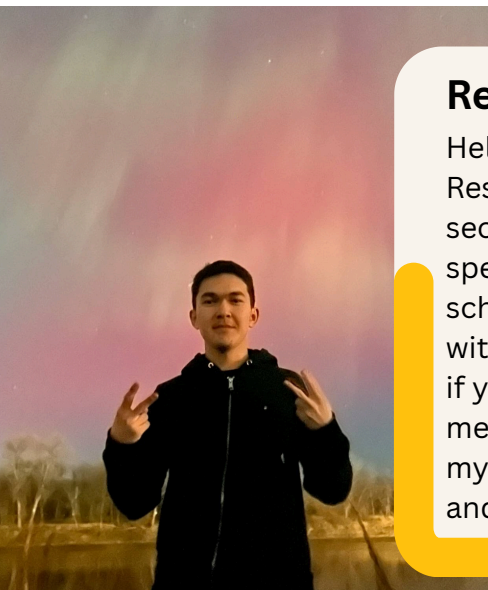
Senior Resident Advisor (5th Floor): Paige Leonardo

Returning Resident Advisor (6th Floor): Daulet Izbergen

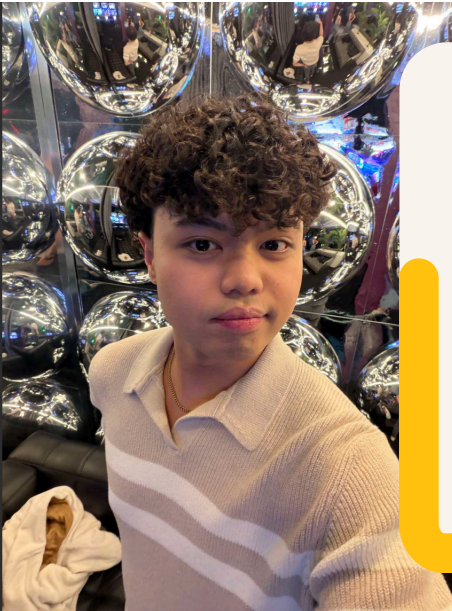

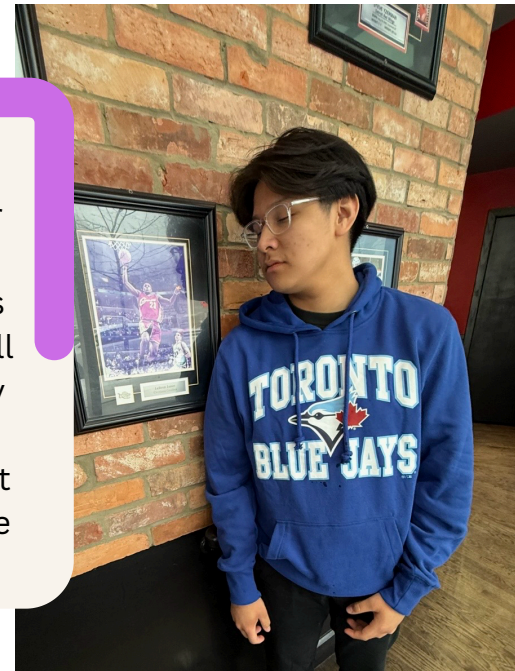


Resident Advisor (10th Floor): Valarie Seger

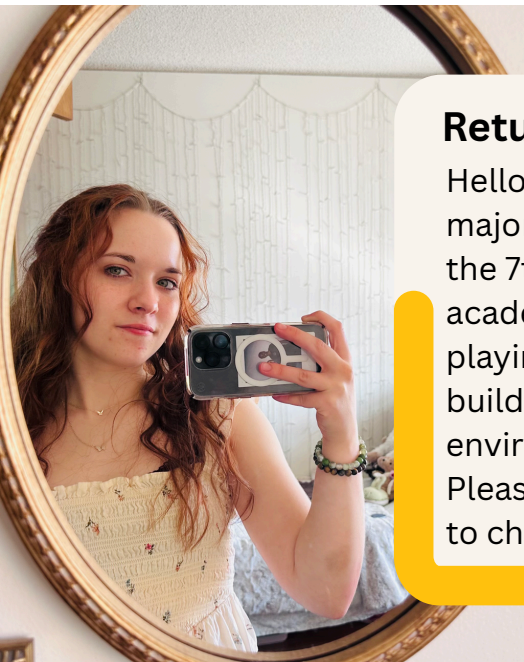
Resident Advisor (5th Floor): Charbel Egwuh

Resident Advisor (8th Floor): Abike Durojaiye

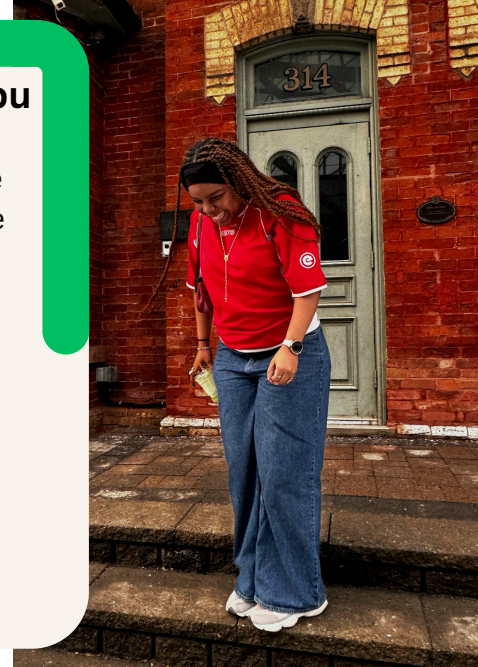

International Resident Advisor (AVM 6th Floor): Kaylah Nyambu

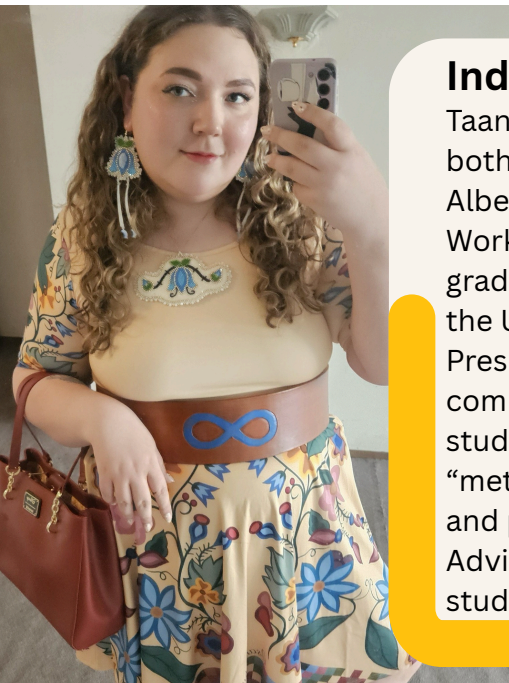
