### BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Mary Ann Pylypchuk, Chair of the Board of Directors, St. Andrew's College, is pleased to announce the appointment of Keith Swinton as Principal of St. Andrew's College effective July 13, 2026. The engagement is on a part-time basis - 20 hours per week. The term of employment is for a period of one year and is renewable upon agreement of the parties.

Keith meets all of the established criteria for the position, i.e., is a member in good standing of the UOCC, has excellent communication skills – multi-lingual and fluent in English and Ukrainian, holds a post graduate degree, possesses extensive experience in senior administrative and leadership roles and, in addition, is a former Board member, is local to Winnipeg and is active in the community. He succeeds the V. Rev. Fr. Dr. Roman Bozyk, the long-time Acting Principal at St. Andrew's College who gave notice, in September of 2025, of his desire to relinquish the Acting Principal role in 2026. Father Bozyk maintains his responsibilities as Dean of Theology; his continuing presence at the College will facilitate Keith's integration into his position.

Keith's appointment follows an exhaustive search process. On receiving Father Bozyk's notice, the Board of Directors of the College determined to hire a new principal on a part-time basis (20 hours per week). To that end, the Board struck a search committee (the Committee) consisting of: the Chair of the Board, Mary Ann Pylypchuk; the Dean of the College, Fr. Bozyk; an Executive member of the Board, Oksana Bondarchuk; and a retired Human Resource professional and former St. Andrew's College Board member, Paul Amiot.

The Committee first undertook a review of and updated the position description then proceeded to create a posting for the position, both subsequently approved by the Board. Key criteria for candidates were identified and the position was advertised with a closing date of November 30, 2025.

Two excellent applications were received. The Committee scheduled and conducted exhaustive interviews in January, after which it did thorough reference checks on the selected candidate. The Committee developed terms and conditions of employment and at a meeting held on January 30, it recommended to the Board that Keith be offered the position commencing July 2026. The Board unanimously adopted the Committee's recommendations and his candidacy was subsequently ratified by the Consistory of the UOCC.

Please join us in welcoming Keith to the College and in wishing him every success in his position.
