2. Faculty Advisor submits the Program Planning Form to Karen Singleton for student's file. Students may retain a copy for their records.
3. Student registers for courses using web registration – Aurora Student.
4. Student and Faculty Advisor (and advisory committee, if applicable) must also complete the Faculty of Graduate Studies ***Program of Study and Appointment of Advisory Committee*** form within the first year of the student beginning the PhD program and/or when the first progress report is due.
