



# HENRY IRVINE GRAHAM ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

**CRITERIA:** The major criterion for selecting the recipient will be a demonstration of how the applicant is 'well-rounded' and has overcome difficulties in order to realize their full potential.

The applicant must:

- be a citizen or permanent resident of Canada;
- be entering the first year of studies at the University of Manitoba with a minimum of 18 credit hours;
- be a member of St John's College;
- have demonstrated exceptional academic promise, diversity of interests and potential for leadership;
- provide a current transcript;

**This scholarship may not be held concurrently with other scholarships totaling more than \$500.** (If you will receive a University of Manitoba entrance scholarship of more than \$500, you may still be eligible for the Graham Scholarship. If you are selected as the Graham recipient, you will be offered the choice of asking the university to reduce your entrance scholarship to \$500 so you may hold both awards.)

Letters should not be received from anyone related to the applicant. Letters must speak to the integrity and character of the applicant (with examples), how the applicant has overcome difficulties to get to where they are, how they are achieving or realizing their potential, and how they are 'well-rounded' and have demonstrated community service. Diversity of interests and leadership potential are essential criteria. Please include letters at time of submission.
