# **CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY**

The Larry and Leta Lee Entrance Scholarship is awarded to students on the basis of the following criteria:

- this scholarship will be given to a student enrolled in the Asper School of Business who demonstrates average or above-average academic achievement, a passion for business or finance, and is actively involved in community service.
- graduate of a Catholic High School and membership at St. Paul's College at time of application\*
- all reference letters must accompany this application before the deadline
- must submit Curriculum Vitae
- high school transcript must be included
  This scholarship is awarded in September at the Opening Academic Exercises.

\*All University of Manitoba students are welcome to apply and to become members of the College by requesting their preference for membership via the Aurora system. Membership fee is \$19 per term.

The application must be received in the Dean's Office prior to or on **August 15** to receive consideration. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be extended until 4:30 p.m. the next business day.
