CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

The J. D. Donoghue Bursary is awarded on the basis of the following criteria:

- students academically engaged or developing skills in communication, public relations, and/or in the study of language
- students must have GPA of 2.5 or higher
- must be full time undergraduate student
- must be a member of St. Paul's College
- students must demonstrate active participation within the College and/or the community in the areas of interest to St. Paul's College
- financial need represents 50% of the criteria and may include special financial circumstances
- financial need for Canadian students is determined by the assessment of need as provided by the Manitoba Student Financial Assistance Program: www.studentaid.gov.mb.ca
- and international students must fill out the Income and Expense Sheet posted online

*All University of Manitoba students are welcome to apply and to become members of the College by requesting their preference for membership via the Aurora system. Membership fee is \$19 per term.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

All applications for The J. D. Donoghue Bursary must be received in the Dean's Office by September 30th to receive consideration. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be extended until 4:00 p.m. the next business day.
