

# ST. PAUL'S COLLEGE IGNATIAN LEADERSHIP PROGRAM – APPLICATION FORM

The Ignatian Leadership Program is a no-cost program for University of Manitoba students who are members of St. Paul's College who are interested in going beyond their university studies and learning how to be community leaders in the Ignatian tradition.

As offered, all program participants will attend a three-hour workshop to learn about and discuss topics of interest relating to Ignatian leadership. In addition, students will meet with each other, and the program directors will share experiences regarding their involvement in the program.

To complete the Ignatian Program and all of its requirements, students must attend all workshops and, during the program of study, choose one of the following two:

- Complete a component of the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises as confirmed by a letter from the person leading these exercises
- Complete (with a passing grade) the Catholic Studies course "The Jesuits: Their Legacy and Influence" (CATH 2300).

Before completing the university degree, program participants must **choose four of the seven** program offerings:

1. Be recognized by the Director of Campus Ministry as having volunteered with SPC Campus Ministry for at least two school terms (these do not have to be consecutive)
2. Participate for one term in at least one service-learning program that is recognized by the University of Manitoba or Campus Ministry at St. Paul's College
3. Complete at least one course in any of the following programs at the University of Manitoba: Catholic Studies (other than the Jesuits in Canada course), Religious Studies or Judaic Studies
4. Participate in an overseas project led by the Near Eastern Biblical Archaeology Laboratory (NEBAL)
5. Complete a Student Leadership Development Program offered by the University of Manitoba:

6. Serve on a recognized College or University of Manitoba student council or committee for at least one term
7. Serve as an active member of any one of the following listed activities for at least one term with a letter of reference from the organization:
  - i. UM Toastmasters (<http://www.umanitoba.ca/campus/groups/toastmasters/>)
  - ii. UM Debating Society
  - iii. A recognized student media outlet (eg. Paulinian, Manitoban, UMF 101.5)
  - iv. Participate in a recognized team sport
  - v. Volunteer to help with a recognized local charity, including the Winnipeg International Storytelling Festival

Upon completing the minimum requirements for the program, each student will receive a signed document from St. Paul's College titled "Recognition of Completion of the Ignatian Leadership Program," received at the Baccalaureate Celebration event.
