The application is not considered submitted until the application fee is received.

Due: **November 1, 2012**

**OFFICIAL Transcripts (TWO copies) from all post secondary education**

INCLUDING transcripts from Exchange, Transfer, Letter of Permission and Colleges. If applicants wish to have their IB or AP courses used in their AGPA these transcripts are also required.

Due: **November 30, 2012**

Notarized copies of international transcripts will be accepted.

If you are currently in studies your transcript should show the courses that you are currently registered in.\*

\*Note: Final transcripts showing final grades for courses taken from Sept 2012-April 2013 will be due **June 15, 2013**.

University of Manitoba students do not submit University of Manitoba transcripts.

**Proof of Canadian Citizenship**

Applicants who are born outside of Canada must submit copies of their Canadian Citizenship, Permanent Residence Card or a copy of their Canadian Passport. This can be sent via mail or emailed to [Jody\\_Dewbury@umanitoba.ca](mailto:Jody_Dewbury@umanitoba.ca). Faxes are not acceptable.

**Proof of English Language Proficiency**

Applicants whose primary language is not English must demonstrate proficiency in English. Please review the specific requirements for Law applicants in the [Applicant Information Bulletin](#) (page 2).

Checklist for Additional Documents:

**Personal Statement (6 copies)**

The personal statement should be 1500 words or less, double spaced. While there are no specific guidelines on what to include in a personal statement, the objectives of the category should be kept in mind. (See page 3 of the [Applicant Information Bulletin](#)) Be sure to include your name (as it appears on your application) and your University of Manitoba Student Number on your statement.

Due: **November 30, 2012**

**Resume (6 copies)**

The resume should highlight work, volunteer and education experience. Maximum length is two (2) pages on 8 ½ x 11 single sided paper.

Due: **November 30, 2012**

**Three (3) Referee Cover Forms with Letters attached**

Applicants must submit three (3) [Referee Cover Forms](#) attached to the reference letters. The form and letter must be sent by the [Referee](#) in a signed and sealed envelope. Referees should be selected to support the personal statement. Referee forms can be found at <http://law.robsonhall.ca/jd/forms>. Refer to the NOTES on page 4 of the [Applicant Information Bulletin](#) for guidelines on selecting Referees.
